In the third sentence of Mr. Hollis' (United States) remarks, delete the phrase "the decision.....escape clause" and replace by the following:

"reliance should be placed on the statements by the contracting party making use of the escape clause in determining whether developments resulting in increased imports had been foreseen,"

In the last sentence of his remarks, delete the phrase "in order to see.....the concession" and replace by the following:

"to report to him any changes which might make it possible partially or completely to restore the concession without the danger of renewed injury".
